Those families have been robbed of the joy brought by a child's graduation or a father walking his daughter down the aisle or any number of dreams they shared together. There is a void. We cannot fill it, though we can answer the call, tell their story, and seek full justice on their behalf.

"Here I am," is not only a declaration. It is a covenant; a solemn promise to do everything in one's power to speak, act, and contribute where others cannot. When a life has been taken, it becomes the responsibility of the living to do more. As a lawyer, that means working harder, digging deeper, and pushing further to obtain full justice. It also means giving people the love, empathy, and respect they want above all else as they learn to live with loss.

No matter our profession or circumstance, so long as we remain among the living, each of us has the opportunity to contribute, to answer the call, and to say, "Here I am."
